PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS: April 11, 1972 marks the fourth anniversary of the passage of the Federal Housing Law, and

WHEREAS: the U. S. Department of Housing and Urban Development is recognized as having the major responsibility for administering this law, and

WHEREAS: many complaints of discrimination in rental or purchase of housing have been successfully resolved through informal HUD conciliation conferences,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby remind citizens that on this day equal housing was guaranteed to all, regardless of race, creed, or color, and I further urge Minnesotans to support this law.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol this fifth day of April, in the year of our Lord, one thousand nine hundred and seventy-two, and of the State, the one hundred and fifteenth.
