- WHEREAS: students of the University of Minnesota and other learning institutions have embarked on a serious and comprehensive selection of projects and contests designed to heighten their ecological consciousness, and
- WHEREAS: their efforts seek to understand the fundamental causes of environmental decay, and
- WHEREAS: these discussions are focusing on the United Nations Conference on the Human Environment to be held in Stockholm in June, and
- WHEREAS: few Americans are aware of this unprecedented international gathering, and
- WHEREAS: people of the world, and specifically, the United States delegation to the United Nations Conference, must recognize it is a lifestyle that is contributing to environmental problems and that, to a degree, each person abuses the earth, and
- WHEREAS: it is the hope of all of us to foster a more cooperative attitude with the planet and other species,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim May 1 - 7, 1972

ENVIRONMENTAL AWARENESS WEEK

and urge all citizens to establish and maintain lines of communication among environmentally concerned scientists, professionals, students, and persons of similar interests throughout the nation.
