The above entitled action, having been brought on for trial,
upon the issue of law joined herein, before the Hon. Stephen A.
Flaherty, Judge of the District Court, in and for the County of Stevens,
State of Minnesota, at chambers in the Court House, in the city of
Morris, on the 11th day of March, A.D. 1912.

Atty. C.B. Randall, appeared for the relator and in sup-
port of the demurrer interposed herein, and Atty. Jas. B. Ormond,
Esq. appeared against said demurrer and for the Defendants and
Respondents herein.

At said trial such proceedings were duly had that the Court
ordered Judgment to be entered in favor of the Plaintiff, and
sustaining said demurrer, herein interposed.

Now, Therefore, Pursuant to said Order for Judgment duly made
and filed herein, and in accordance therewith, It is Adjudged,
Determined and Decreed that Judgment be and is hereby entered as
follows, to-wit:

That the Incorporation of the Village of Albert, in Stevens
County, Minnesota, is Void and Illegal, and that all the Incorporation
Proceedings thereof are hereby vacated; that the respondents
herein, who now are acting as members of the Village Council
thereof, viz: T. A. Maanum, Wm. T. Pederson, L. J. Schlattmann and
Henry Guhrt, are hereby Ousted and forbidden their acting further
as such officers, or in any way longer holding such offices ;
and further that the Complainant herein, the State of Minnesota,
have and recover of the Defendants, T. A. Maanum, Wm. T.

Poderson, L. J. Schlattman, and Henry Gihrt, the sum of Thirteen
no/100 (\$13.00) Dollars, Costs and Disbursements of this action, .
that Execution for the collection of said amount shall be issued
as in civil causes.

It is further ordered, that this Decree is entered without
prejudice as to any future incorporation or attempted incorporation
of such tract or part thereof.

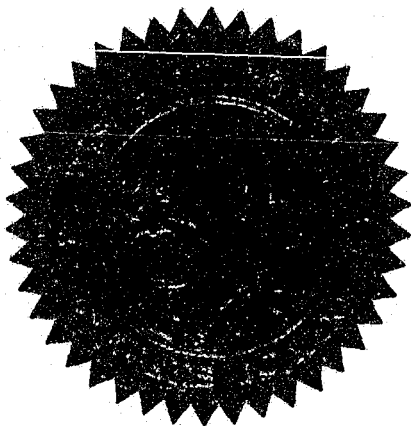
