PROCLAMATION

- WHEREAS: the sport of bicycling has reached an all-time high in popularity, with over 65 million adults and children in the United States riding bicycles for recreation, health, and transportation; and
- WHEREAS: the bicycle offers no abnormal stress to our natural physical and mental being and provides wholesome exercise and promotes physical fitness; and
- WHEREAS: the bicycle allows participation in family-oriented activities; and
- WHEREAS: there is a need to focus the attention of the public on the importance of bicycling as an alternative mode of transportation and as an aid to alleviating environmental and other health problems;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim May 1 - 2, 1972 as

NATIONAL BICYCLOGY WEEK

in Minnesota and all members of the public are encouraged to participate in such observance.
