WHEREAS: the purpose of the Minnesota Federation of Croatian Lodges is to keep the Croatian traditions alive and to help the younger generation to understand the customs, dance, music and language, and

WHEREAS: through annual celebrations, festivals and sporting events can be created a spirit of fraternalism and pride amongst our people for their heritage and recognition of the fact that such spirit has much to offer America in the years to come, and

WHEREAS: Minnesota has been selected as the site of the 30th annual Croatian Fraternal Union National Curling Tournament, an event which brings to the state people of Croatian descent from all over the United States and Canada during the week of May 15,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota do hereby proclaim the week of May 15 through May 21, 1972 as

"CROATIAN WEEK"

In Minnesota, and urge all of our citizens to mark this observance, paying tribute to the outstanding contribution made by the people of Croatian descent to Minnesota.
