NOW, THEREFORE, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, acting pursuant to the provisions of Section 490.101(I), do heroby order and direct the retirement of the Monorable Letlie L. Anderson, effective at the close of business on May 21, 1972, and further direct that this Order be filed in the Office of the Secretary of State of the State of Minnesota, at which time said retirement of the Honorable Leslie L. Anderson shall become effective and he shall become entitled thereafter to retirement compensation pursuant to M.S. 490.102.

My dear Governor

I apply herewith to retire under the provisions of M.S. 490.101. Subd. 1, as a Judge of District Court of this State, effective as of the close of the day on May 21, 1972, subject to the further condition set forth below. I request, accordingly, that you direct this retirement by a written order to be filed in the Office of the Secretary of State. A duplicate of this letter is enclosed to be filed with the order.

While I am in disagreement with the present interpretation given to the statute by the State of Minnesota, and have instituted judicial pproceedings to clarify the law. I cannot afford the risk of losing such retirement benefits as the State may provide.

I am, therefore, submitting my resignation from my present office to which I have been elected; but in no way am I waiving any of my rights as they may ultimately be established by the Minnesota SupremeCourt in the pending legal proceedings. This notice of resignation is not voluntary and is with full reservation of my rights as they may be ultimately established. Under the conditions and pursuant to the existing trial court interpretation of the law, I waive the full compensation of district court judges in Hennepin County for the remainder of my term beginning as of May 22, 1972, in order to receive retirement pay.

I was appointed Judge of Municipal Court for Minneapolis on August 29, 1949, to fill an unexpired term and thereafter was elected to a full six year term on that Court. I was appointed Judge of the District Court, Fourth Judicial District, on January 10, 1952, and was elected and reelected to six year terms on that Court in 1952, 1958, 1964 and 1970.

I have served continuously and without interruption on courts of record in this State from August 29, 1949, to the present. My current term began on the first Monday in January 1971 and will end on the first Monday in January 1977.
