CONSENT
TO BE JUDGE OF COUNTY COURT

By Chapter 951, Laws 1971, amending Minnesota Statutes 1969, Chapter 525.01, establishing Mille Lacs and Kanabec County Court District and further providing that in counties hereby combined into County Court Districts and for which only one Judge is provided, the Probate Judge of the county having the largest population determined by the last United States census shall be the Judge of the County Court if he consents and files his consent prior to July 1, 1972 in the office of the Secretary of State.

The County of Mille Lacs has a larger population than the County of Kanabec according to the last United States census.


NOW THEREFORE, I Leonard M. Paulson, Judge of Probate and Juvenile Court for Mille Lacs County, Minnesota, do hereby consent to serve as Judge of Mille Lacs and Kanabec County Court District when, and at such time as said County Court District is implemented and do hereby agree and consent to serve and discharge the duties as Judge of the said Mille Lacs and Kanabec County Court District during my term in office.







JUDICIAL OATH


