AFFIDAVIT

I, Paul Kimball, Jr., being duly sworn and upon my oath depose
and say that:

1. I am the duly elected, qualified, and acting Judge of Probate Court in and for Mower County, Minnesota.
2. That I was last so elected on November 3rd, 1970, with my current term of office commencing on January 1st, 1971, and expiring on December 31st, 1976.
3. That Chapter 951 of the Minnesota Laws of 1971 establishes the County of Mower as a County Court District and affiant as the Probate Court Judge will become the Judge of County Court of the District of Mower on July 1st, 1972, by operation of this act.
4. That in assuming such position affiant takes the following Oath of Office:


