AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE VILLAGE OF MINNECIKA TO INCLUDE CERTAIN UNINCORPORATED PLATTED LAND (UNPLATTED LAND NOT EXCEEDING 200 ACRES IN AREA) ADJUTING UPON THE VILLAGE LIMITS.

WHEREAS, a certain petition dated December 15, 1971, requesting annexation of the territory hereinafter described was duly presented to the council on the 15th day of December, 1971, and

WHEREAS, the quantity of land embraced within the area described in the petition and bounded as described is 104.7 acres of platted and unplatted land, no part of which is included within the limits of an incorporated city, village, or borough; and

WHEREAS, the petition was signed by 24 owners, constituting a majority but not all of a total number of 36 owners; and

WHEREAS, no objections to the annexation have been received from the town board, the county board, or the governing body of any municipality whose jurisdiction abuts upon the boundaries of the land to be annexed; and

WHEREAS, a hearing was duly held by the governing body of the Village of Minnetonka, Minnesota, on the proposed annexation after at least 30 days mailed notice; and

WHEREAS, the land described in the petition abuts upon the village limits at the southeast boundary thereof;

The council of the Village of Minnetonka, Minnesota, ordains:

Section 1. The village council hereby determines (1) that the annexation will be to the best interests of the village and of the territory affected; (2) that the territory described herein abuts upon the village limits and is about to become urban in character; and (3) that none of said territory is now included within the limits of any city, village, or borough.

Section 2. Territory Annexed. The corporate limits of the village are hereby extended to include the platted and unplatted land described as follows and the same is hereby annexed to and included within the village as effectually as if it had originally been a part thereof:

North One-Half of the North One-Half (1/2 1/2) of Section Two (2) Township One Hundred Eight (108) North Range Nine (9) West, County of Winona, State of Minnesota, including the portion presently within the Village limits of the Village of Minnetonka.

Section 3. Filing. The village clerk is hereby directed to file certified copies of this ordinance with the Minnesota Municipal Commission, the Secretary of State, and the County Auditor.


Section 4. Effective Date. This ordinance takes effect upon its passage and publication and the filing of the certified copies as directed in Section 3.



TO THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF MINNEISKA, MINNESOTA

We, the undersigned, a majority of the owners of the territory described below, hereby request the council to annex this territory to the village and extend the village boundaries to include the same, and for that purpose respectfully state:

1. The territory to be annexed consists partially of lands which have been platted into lots and blocks, which plat has been lawfully made and certified according to the laws of this state and filed in the office of the Register of Deeds of Winona County, Minnesota, and partly of unplatted lands not exceeding 20 acres in area. All of these lands lie entirely within the County of Winona, Minnesota and the description of such lands is as follows:

North One-Half of the North One-Half (N. 1/2) Section Two (2) Township One Hundred First (101st) North Range Nine (9th) West, County of Winona, State of Minnesota, excluding the portion presently within the Village limits of the Village of Minneiska.

2. The territory described above abuts upon the village limits at the Southwest boundary thereof and none of it is presently included within the corporate limits of any incorporated city, village, or borough.
3. All of this territory is or is about to become urban or suburban in character.
