

EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 27

Providing for assistance to  
Civil Law Authorities to quell  
disorder at the University of  
Minnesota, Minneapolis Campus

I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, by virtue of the authority vested in me by the Constitution and applicable statutes, hereby issue this Executive Order:

WHEREAS, civil disturbances have erupted at the University of Minnesota to such a degree that the lives of persons and safety of personal property are endangered; and

WHEREAS, the capability of civil authorities to cope with a civil disturbance of such magnitude is being taxed to the extreme, resulting in the possibility of a loss of control thereof;

NOW, THEREFORE, I order that:


1. The Adjutant General of Minnesota will order to active duty in service of the State such organizations, units and individuals as are necessary to protect lives and property during this period of unrest, and that
2. Cost of subsistence, transportation, pay and allowances of said individuals will be defrayed from the General Revenue of the State, as provided for by Minnesota Statutes, Section 192.49; Subdivision 1, Section 192.51; and Section 192.52.


This Order shall be effective on 10 May 1972.
