Tract No. 43 should be amended to describe Lot Five (5) and the West Half (W1/2) of Lot Six (6) of Audi-tor's First Subdivision.

tor's First Subdivision. The Village Clerk submitted proof that notice of the hearing was mailed to each property owner affected on Docember 9, 1971. The Village Coun-cil found that more than 60 days had elapsed since the filling of copies of the petition with the various govern-mental agencies as required by law, and that there had been no objection to the petition for annexation. A number of property owners were present and were heard, but there was no objection to the annexation in accordance with the petition filed and as amended.
