Whereas, since about mid-year 1959, the Probate Court of Wilkin County has, in fact, operated as a County Court, with the exception of greater added jurisdiction granted by Chapter.

951 of the Laws of Minnesota for 1971; and

Whereas, said Chapter 951 combines the counties of Wilkin,
Big Stone and Traverse into one county court district, but
permits, by concurrence of the county boards of said counties,
the district to separate into single county court districts; and

Whereas, the attorneys and law enforcement officers and officials of Wilkin County and surrounding areas have expressed a desire to have Wilkin County as a single county court district; and the County Commissioners of Wilkin County being satisfied that it is desireable and best that Wilkin County operate as a single county court district;

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, by the Board of County Commissioners of Wilkin County that said County Court District of Wilkin, Big Stone and Traverse counties separate into single county court districts; and that the Wilkin County Court District commence operating as such single county court district on July 1, 1972.
