Persuent to due call and motion thorough, a special modifies of the Village at the Village of St. Joseph, Edmasota, was hold in the Village Hall in said Village on the 22nd day of Harch, 1972 at 8:00 P.H.

The following members were present: Mayor, George Enstin, Trustees, Merman Schmeider, Marvey Bets, and Reman Rober. Also present were Village Clerk, Robert C. Schmeen, Village Attorney, John Enepp, and Robert Brichson, representing Milner W. Carley and Adsociates. Absent was councilmen, Donald Rober.

The mosting was called to order by Mayor, George Gastin.

The Village Attermey, then presented an Affidavit showing that a copy of the Potition for Ammaration was sent to Mr. David Taraker, the Township Clerk of the Termship of St. Jesoph, Mr. Arnold Hinnenkamp, the County Auditor and the Minnesota Employed County St. Jesus is non the 18th day of January, 1972 and that the Termship Clerk and the County Auditor asknowledged receipt of the Petition on January 20, 1972. John Enapp, the Village Attorney also presented an Affidavit showing that a copy of the Motice for Hearing on Annexation was mailed to all of the property owners within the area to be annexed on the 14th day of February, 1972. Said affidavits were examined, found satisfactory and ordered placed on file in the office of the Village Clerk.

The Mayer then announced that the meeting was open for the consideration by the Germail of the views of all persons interested with reference to the annexation of the lands described in the Petition for Annexation which was filed with the Council of January 10, 1972 signed by John A. Lose and eighteen other property owners.

Appreximately 40 persons appeared at the hearing and several of them voiced objection to the amexation.

After fall consideration, member Herman Schneider introduced the following ordinance and moved its adoption:

AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE VILLAGE OF ST. JOSEPH TO INCLUDE CERTAIN UNINCORPORATED LAND PARTLY PLATTED AND PARTLY UNPLATTED NOT EXCENDING 200 AGRES IN AREA ABUTTING UPON THE VILLAGE LIMITS.

WHEREAS, a certain Potition containing 19 signatures requesting annoration of the territory hereinafter described was duly presented to the Council on the 10th day of January, 1972; and

WHEREAS, the quantity of land embraced within the area described in the Potition and bounded as described is approximately 14 acres of platted and unplatted land, no part of which is included within the limits of an incorporated city, village, or borrough; and

WHEREAS, the Petition was signed by 19 owners, constituting a majority but not all of a total of 35 owners; and

WHEREAS, no objections to the annexation have been received from the Town Board, the County Board, and the boundaries of no other municipalities bbut the boundaries of the land to be amnexed; and

WHEREAS, a hearing was duly held by the governing body of the Village of St.

Joseph, Minnesota, on the proposed annexation after least 30 days mailed notice to each of the property owners within the area to be annexed; and

WHEREAS, the land describes in the Petition abuts upon the village limits at the easterly boundary thereof;

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the Village of St. Joseph, Minnesota, ordains:

Section 1. The Village Council hereby determines that the annexation will be to the best interest of the Village and of the territory affected; that the territory described herein abuts upon the Village limits and is or is about to become urban or sub-urban in character; and that none of said territory is now included within the limits of any city, village or borrough.

Section 2. Territory Annexed. The corporate limits of the Village of St.

Joseph are hereby extended to include the platted and unplatted land described as follows and the same is hereby annexed to and included within the Village of St.

Joseph as effectually as if it had originally been a part thereof:

The North Sixty Six (56) feet of the Southwest Quarter of the Southeast Quarter (SW\(\frac{1}{4}\)SE\(\frac{1}{4}\)), and that part of the Easterly One Thousand (1000) feet of the Northwest Quarter of the Southeast Quarter (NW\(\frac{1}{4}\)SE\(\frac{1}{4}\)) lying Southerly of the centerline of former Trunk Highway No. 52, and lying easterly of the tract annexed to the Village of St. Joseph by Ordinance No. 1971-C adopted July 8, 1971, and recorded in the office of the Register of Deeds of Steams

Gernty, Michosota, in Book 111 of Miscellancous on pages 583 and 564, all of cold lands boing in Section 10 (Tem), Township One Hundred Tremty Pear (124) North, of Rango Trenty Nine (29) Hoot, Steams County, Minnesota. The Magner-Nett Subdivision is included within.

Scales 3. Filing. The Village Clerk is bereby directed to file certified copies of this Ordinance with the Mannesota Municipal Commission, the Secretary of State, the County Auditor, and the Begister of Doods.

Scotion 4. Effective Date. This Ordinance takes effect upon its passage and publication and the filing of the certified copies as directed in Section 3.
