

ORDINANCE NO. 101

AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE VILLAGE OF LAKE PARK TO INCLUDE CERTAIN UNINCORPORATED PLATTED LAND (UNPLATTED LAND NOT EXCEEDING 200 ACRES IN AREA) ABUTTING UPON THE VILLAGE LIMITS.

WHEREAS, a certain petition dated June 1971 requesting annexation of the territory hereinafter described was duly presented to the council on the 12 day of July, 19 71; and

WHEREAS, the quantity of land embraced within the area described in the petition and bounded as described is 10 acres of platted (unplatted) land, no part of which is included within the limits of an incorporated city, village or borough; and

WHEREAS, the petition was signed by all owners; and

WHEREAS, no objections to the annexation have been received from the town board, the county board, or the governing body of any municipality whose boundaries abut upon the boundaries of the land to be annexed; and

WHEREAS, the land described in the petition abuts upon the village limits at the south boundary thereof;

The council of the Village of Lake Park, of Lake Park, Minnesota, ordains:

Section 1. The Village council hereby determines (1) that the annexation will be to the best interests of the village and of the territory affected; (2) that the territory described herein abuts upon the village limits and is urban or suburban in character; and (3) that none of said territory is now included within the limits of any city, village or borough.

Section 2. Territory Annexed. The corporate limits of the village are hereby extended to include the platted (unplatted) land described as follows and the same is hereby annexed to and included within the village as effectually as if it had originally been a part thereof:

A 10.0 acre tract of land in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 10, Twp. 139 North of Rge 43 West of the 5th P.M. in Becker County, Minn. described as follows to-wit:

Beginning at a point (iron monument) on the South line of State Hwe. #10 located as follows: Commencing at the Northeast corner of said Section 10; thence proceeding W'ly 891.3 feet on and along the North line of said Section 10; thence proceeding S'ly 150.0 feet at right angles to the North line of said 10 to the said point of beginning. Thence running S'ly 534.5 feet at right angles to the North line of said Section 10 to an iron stake; thence running E'ly 823.8 feet parallel with the North line of said Section 10 to an iron monument on the West line of the County Hwy., said point being also located 50.0 feet West from the East line of said Section 10; thence running N'ly on and along the West line of the County Hwy. and parallel with the East line of said Sec. 10 to an intersection with the right-of-way line of State Hwy. #10; thence running NW'ly along the right-of-way line of State Hwy. #10 to a point located 150.0 feet S'ly from the North line of said Sec. 10 when measured at right angles therefrom; thence running W'ly parallel with the North line of said Sec. 10 and being on and along the South right-of-way line of State Hwy. #10 to the point of beginning and there terminating.

Section 3. Filing. The village clerk is hereby directed to file certified copies of this ordinance with the Minnesota Municipal Commission, the Secretary of State, and the County Auditor.

Section 4. Effective Date. This ordinance takes effect upon its passage and publication and the filing of the certified copies as directed in Section 3.
