ORDINANCE NO. 105

AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE VILLAGE OF SOUTH INTERNATIONAL FALLS, MINNESOTA TO INCLUDE CERTAIN UNINCORPORATED PLATTED LAND AND UNPLATTED LAND NOT EXCEEDING A TOTAL OF 200 ACRES IN AREA ABUTTING UPON THE VILLAGE LIMITS

WHEREAS: Certain petitions dated February 23, February 26, December 13, and December 20, 1971, requesting ammeration of the territory hereinafter described were duly presented to the council on the 20th day of December, 1971; and

WHEREAS: the quantity of land embraced within the area described in the petition and bounded as described is 105 acres of platted and unplatted land, no part of which is included within the limits of an incorporated city, village, or borough; and

WHEREAS: the petition was signed by 8 owners, constituting a majority but not all of a total number of ten owners; and

WHEREAS: no objections to the annexation have been received from the county board, or the governing body of any municipality whose boundaries abut upon the boundaries of the land to be annexed; and

WHEREAS: a hearing was duly held by the governing body of the Village of South International Falls, Minnesota, on the proposed annexation after at least 30 days mailed notice; and

WHEREAS: the land described in the petition abuts upon the village limits at the South boundary thereof;

The Council of the Village of South International Falls, Minnesota, ordains:

Section 1. The village council hereby determines (1) that the annexation will be to the best interests of the village and of the territory affected; (2) that the territory described herein abuts upon the village limits and is urban or suburban in character; and (3) that none of said territory is now included within the limits of any city, village, or borough.

Section 2. Territory Annexed. The corporate limits of the village are hereby extended to include the platted and unplatted land described as follows and the same is hereby annexed to and included within the village as effectually as if it had originally been a part thereof: NW4 SW4 of Sec. 11, Twsp. 70, Range 24 (includes the Plat of Allen's Acres), SE4 SW4 of Sec. 11, Twsp. 70, Range 24, and W2 Lot 2, Lots 3 & 4, Auditor's Plat No. 1. SATD lands shall be included in the commercial industrial district of the village. Section 3. Filing. The village clerk is hereby directed to file certified copies of this ordinance with the Minnesota Municipal Commission, the Secretary of State, and the County Auditor.

Section 4. Effective Date. This ordinance takes effect upon its passage and publication and the filing of the certified copies as directed in Section 3.
