ORDINANCE NO 1429

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING to the City of Rochester, Minnesota, Certain Platited, Lands in the Golden Hill Addition, Olmsted County, Minnesota, and Establishing the Zoning Therefor.

THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROCHESTER DO ORDAIN:
Section 1. A petition has been fitted with the Common Council of the City of Rochester, signed by a majority of the owners of the land described herein, requesting the Common Council to annex said land to the City of Rochester. The land described in Rochester Township, Olmsted County, Minnesota, and is described as follows:

The East 100 feet of Lot 5, Block 2, and the West half of the abulting street known as 3rd Avenue Southwest bounded by an extension of said lof lines, all in the Golden Hill Addition to the City of Rochester, Olmsted County, Minnesota, according to the, recorded plat thereof on file in the office of the Register of Deeds in and for Olmsted County, Sald petition has also been filed with the Town Board of Rochester Township, with the County Board of the County of Olmsted, and with the Minnesota Municipal Commission and more than 60 days have elapsed since said petition was filed with the Town Board and no objections to annexation of the above described land have been filed by said Town Board with the Minnesota Municipal Commission.

Section 2. The common Council of the City of Rochester, is so conditioned as to be properly subjected to municipal government, and the annexation of said petition is approximately 0.55 acres.

Section 3. The Common Council of the City of Rochester, Minnesota, as effectively as it is had originally been a part thereof.

Section 4. Therefore, the land described in Section 1 above 1s hereby annexed, added to and made a part of the City of Rochester, Minnesota, in a land described in Section 5. Present and fulure owners of the acres of any slorm sewer, water tower, and frunk line sanitary sewer construction, herefore or hereafter undertaken to serve the area annexed.
