ORDINANCE NO. 1638

AN ORDINANCE Annexing to the City at Rochester, Minnesota, Certain Umplatfed Land not Exceeding 200 Acres in Area, all Being in Section 12. Township 108 North, Range 14 West, Olmsted County, Minnesotar and Establishing the Zoning Therefor.

THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROCHESTER DO ORDAIN:
Section 1. A petition has been tiled with the Common Council of the City of Rochester, signed by a majority of the owners of the land described herein, requesting the Common Council to annex said land the Common Council to annex said land to the City of Rochester. The land described in said petition for annexation is located in Rochester Township. Climsted County, Minnesola, and is described as follows:

Commencing at the northeast corner of said Section 12, running thence west along the north line of said section 467.3 feet to the center line of Trunk Highway No. 52, thence southeasterly along the center line of said Trunk Highway, 177 feet for a place of beginning, thence southeasterly along the center line of Trunk Highway a distance, of 187.36 feet, thence south 74 degrees 10 west 160 feet, thence north 22 degrees 31 west 173.36 feet, thence north 49 degrees 11 east 210 feet to the center line of Said Trunk Highway and the place of beginning, subject to the rener line of Said Trunk Highway and the place of beginning, subject to the rights of the State of Minnesota in the easterly 50 thereof for highway purposes.
