Chapter #47.

An Ordinance relating to the Annexation of Certain Territory to the Village of International Falls:-

The Village Council of the Village of International Falls do ordain as follows:-

Section 1.

That the following described premises, to-wit:-

All those portion of sections twenty seven (27) and thirty four (34) in town seventy one (71) north of range twenty four (24) west, in Koochiching county, Minnesota, lying northerly of the present boundary line of the Village of International Falls, be and the same is hereby annexed and attached to the said Village of International Falls, and that from and after the adoption of this ordinance said territory described shall be and become for all purposes a part of the territory of said Village.

That ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
