I, Charles Wittmanson, Mayor of the City of Warren, in the County of Marshall, State of Minnesota, do hereby certify, that on March 27th, 1912 a charter commission was appointed in accordance with Section 26, Article 6 of the Constitution of the State of Minnesota and Chapter 9 of the Revised Laws of Minnesota for the year 1905, and acts amendatory thereof and supplementary thereto, for the purpose of framing a charter for the said City of Warren; that the annexed and foregoing Charter of the City of Warren was delivered to the chief executive of said City of Warren by the said Charter Commission, as a draft of a proposed charter and requested that the same be submitted to the qualified voters of said City of Warren for adoption; that the city council of the said City of Warren thereafter resolved and ordered a special election to be held on the 17th day of March, 1914, for the purpose of submitting to the voters of the said City of Warren the question of the adoption of the said proposed city charter; that the said proposed charter was duly submitted to the qualified voters of the said City of Warren on the said 17th day of March, A. D. 1914, and was by the said voters duly adopted and ratified by more than four-sevenths (4/7) of the qualified voters voting at said election.
