

I, H. N. Melvey, Mayor of the City of Moorhead,  
in the County of Clay and State of Minnesota, hereby certify that the  
attached Amendments to the Charter of the City of Moorhead, were on  
the 2nd, day of January, 1917, proposed by the Board of Charter  
Commissioners, delivered to the City and Council of the City of Moor-  
head, duly published for thirty (30) days in three newspapers of  
general circulation in the City of Moorhead, duly submitted to the voters  
of the City of Moorhead at the General City Election held on the 20th,  
day of February, 1917, for the purpose of voting on said proposed amend-  
ment; and at such election said amendments were duly adopted by the legal  
voters of said City, Amendment No. 1 receiving 759 votes in favor of the  
adoption of said amendment, and 196 being cast against the adoption;  
Amendment No. 2, 655 votes were cast in favor of the adoption of said  
amendment, and 266 being cast against the adoption of such amendment;  
997 votes being cast at such election.

# PROPOSED AMENDMENTS

TO THE CHARTER OF THE CITY OF  
MOORHEAD, MINNESOTA.

To the Honorable J. C. Vincent, Mayor,  
and the Council of the City of Moorhead,  
Minnesota.

The undersigned, members of the Board of Freeholders of the city of Moorhead, Minnesota, appointed July 10th, 1913, by the Honorable, the District Court of the State of Minnesota, of the Seventh Judicial District of said state, in and for the County of Clay therein, in which is situated the said City of Moorhead, as the Charter Commission for said City of Moorhead, and who constitute a majority of the members of said Board of Freeholders, do hereby respectfully propose the following amendments to the charter of said City of Moorhead, which said charter was duly adopted as such by said city on May 22nd, 1900; and said Board of Freeholders, having duly adopted said amendments do hereby submit the same as proposed amendments to said charter, to the Honorable J. C. Vincent, mayor of said City of Moorhead, and to the council of said city, to be submitted to the electors of said city as provided by law, to-wit:

## FIRST AMENDMENT.

To amend Sec. 197, of Chapter XII, Part 3, Division I, as follows: By adding at the end thereof the following proviso:

PROVIDED, further, that for the years 1917 and 1918, only, if the Permanent Improvement Revolving Fund shall contain sufficient funds to pay one-half the estimated cost of the proposed improvement, in addition to the cost of all other improvements then under construction or contract, but not otherwise, the council may cause proposals for doing the work to be advertised for.

## SECOND AMENDMENT.

To amend Section 178, Chapter XII, of Part II, Division I, by adding thereto the following paragraph:

The cost of paving street intersections shall be assessed against the property benefited thereby.
