



JON K. MURPHY


of New Brighton, Minnesota, as Special Assistant Attorney General to the Department of the Attorney General for the period commencing July 19, 1972, and to serve at the pleasure of the Attorney General or until this appointment shall be revoked or otherwise terminated in accordance with law; and I hereby fix the compensation of said JON K. MURPHY at the sum of Twelve Thousand, One Hundred, Twenty Five Dollars (\$12,125) per annum, one-fourth of said amount to be paid from the appropriation made for the Department of the Attorney General and three-fourths of said amount to be paid from the Milk and Dairy Fund.

IN TESTIMONY WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand at St. Paul, Minnesota, this 19th day of July, 1972.




