ORDINANCE NO. 34

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING  
TRACTS OF LAND TO THE  
VILLAGE OF EDGERTON,  
MINNESOTA.

The Village Council of the  
Village of Edgerton do ordain  
as follows:

Section 1. That the following described tracts of land adjoining the limits of the Village of Edgerton so situated that 100% of one line of boundary thereof lies on and touches the boundary lines of the Village of Edgerton, all of which land is located in the County of Pipestone, State of Minnesota, is hereby added to and taken into and made a part of the Village of Edgerton pursuant to Minnesota Statutes of the laws of 1959, Chapter 686, Section thru and cited as MSA Chapter 414.033, Subdivision 5 and 7:

a. Beginning at a point known as the Center Post of Sections 21 and 28; thence Westerly for 1320 feet along the boundary line of said Sections 21 and 28 to the Westerly boundary of the Village of Edgerton, being the point of beginning, thence Northerly along the Westerly boundary of the Village of Edgerton for a distance of 248 feet; thence at left angles in a westerly direction and parallel with the boundary lines of Sections 21 and 28 for a distance of 403.25 feet; thence at left angles in a Southerly direction parallel with the Westerly boundary of the Village of Edgerton for a distance of 940.45 feet; thence at left angles in an Easterly direction for 403.25 feet to the Westerly boundary of the Village of Edgerton; thence at left angles along the Westerly boundary of the Village of Edgerton in a Northerly direction for a distance of 892.45 feet to the point of beginning. Said land being a part of Sections 21 and 28, Township 105, Range 44 West, of the 5th P. M.

Section 2. That on the taking effect of this ordinance, the corporate limits and boundary lines of the Village of Edgerton shall hereafter be known and do include the tracts of land set out in paragraph one above.

Section 3. That the lands described in Section 1 of this ordinance are hereby assigned to and made part of the Village of Edgerton, County of Pipestone, State of Minnesota.

Section 4. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in The Edgerton Enterprise, the official village newspaper in the Village of Edgerton, Minnesota, and as provided by MSA 414.032, Subdivisions 5 and 7.

ORDINANCE NO. 34

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TRACTS OF LAND TO THE VILLAGE OF EDGERTON, MINNESOTA.

THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF EDGERTON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the following described tracts of land adjoining the limits of the Village of Edgerton be situated that 1000 of one line of boundary thereof lies on and touches the boundary lines of the Village of Edgerton, all of which land is located in the County of Pipestone, State of Minnesota, is hereby added to and taken into and made a part of the Village of Edgerton pursuant to Minnesota Statutes of the Laws of 1939, Chapter 606, Section thru and cited as MSA Chapter 414.033, Subdivisions 5 and 7:

a. Beginning at a point known as the Center Post of Sections 21 and 28; thence Westerly for 1330 feet along the boundary line of said Sections 21 and 28 to the Westerly boundary of the Village of Edgerton, being the point of beginning, thence Northerly along the Westerly boundary of the Village of Edgerton for a distance of 248 feet; thence at left angles in a Westerly direction and parallel with the boundary lines of Sections 21 and 28 for a distance of 403.25 feet; thence at left angles in a Southerly direction parallel with the Westerly boundary of the Village of Edgerton for a distance of 940.45 feet; thence at left angles in an Easterly direction for 403.25 feet to the Westerly boundary of the Village of Edgerton; thence at left angles along the Westerly boundary of the Village of Edgerton in a Northerly direction for a distance of 692.45 feet to the point of beginning. Said land being a part of Sections 21 and 28, Township 10S, Range 44 West, of the 5th P.M.

Section 2. That on the taking effect of this ordinance, the corporate limits and boundary lines of the Village of Edgerton shall hereafter be known and do include the tracts of land set out in paragraph one above.

Section 3. That the lands described in Section 1 of this ordinance are hereby assigned to and made a part of the Village of Edgerton, County of Pipestone, State of Minnesota.

Section 4. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in The Edgerton Enterprise, the official village newspaper in the Village of Edgerton, Minnesota, and as provided by MSA 414.032, Subdivisions

5 and 7.
