- WHEREAS: such satisfaction can be not only synonymous with our individual happiness, compassion and vitality, but also cause for gratitude that creators of art experience have existed, do and will always exist as long as that spirit of man, which cannot be measured, exists.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim May 14 - 20, 1972 as

MINNESOTA ARTISTS AND ARTS WEEK

in Minnesota, and it is to this end that artists, their champions, their audiences, and all who are arts celebrants dedicate themselves with mutual respect, understanding, and awareness of their common identifications with that which is both immediate and continuing.
