PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS: more Minnesotans each year are turning to boating as a form of recreation and relaxation, and

WHEREAS: boating is especially important to a land of 10,000 lakes, and

WHEREAS: there were 1,507 lives lost in boating accidents in 1971, it is obvious the need for boat safety and boat safety education grows more acute, and

WHEREAS: Congress, by a joint resolution, asked that a week be set aside as National Safe Boating Week, and

WHEREAS: the President has designated the week beginning July 2, 1972 as National Safe Boating Week,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota do hereby designate the week of July 2 - 8, 1972 as

"NATIONAL SAFE BOATING WEEK"

in Minnesota and I urge all who use Minnesota lakes and waterways to learn those skills essential to their own safety and the safety of others and to apply them carefully.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol this twenty-eighth day of June in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and seventy-two, and of the State, the one hundred fiftieth.
