

PROPOSED AMENDMENT TO THE CITY  
CHARTER OF THE CITY OF CROOKSTON RECOMMENDED  
BY THE CHARTER COMMISSION.

September 23rd, 1918.

PROPOSED AMENDMENT NO.1.

Amend Subdivision 4, Section 34, Chapter  
VII, so as to read as follows:

"4. Not to exceed two mills on the dol-  
lar for the Park fund."

The foregoing is a draft of the proposed  
amendment to the city charter of the City of Crookston,  
framed and adopted by the Commission appointed by the Judges  
of the District Court of the 14th Judicial District, State  
of Minnesota, under and pursuant to Section 36, article 4,  
of the Constitution of the State of Minnesota, and Sections  
1342 and 1353 of the General Statutes of Minnesota, for the  
year 1913.

And said draft of said proposed amend-  
ment of said charter is hereby returned to the Honorable  
Jas. E. Morrissey, Mayor of said City, to be submitted to  
the voters according to law.
