Commencing at the Northwest corner of the Northeast Quarter (NE 1/4) of the Northwest Quarter (NW 1/4) of Section 32, Township 107 North, Range 15 West for a place of beginning, then Southerly along the West line of said Northeast Quarter (NE 1/4) of the Northwest Quarter (NW 1/4) of said Section 32 to the North right-of-way line of the Chicago and Northwestern Railway railroad track, then Easterly along the said North right-of-way line to a point 20 rods West of the West right-of-way line of West Street, then Northerly along a line 20 rods West of the West right-of-way line of West Street to the North line of said Section 32, then Westerly along the North line of said Section 32 to the place of beginning, Olmsted County, Minnesota,
