

P R O C L A M A T I O N

WHEREAS, The United States of America, pursuant to federal law and rules and regulations promulgated thereunder, will be able to make available to the State of Minnesota funds for a proposed Iron Range Interpretative Center to be located in the State of Minnesota, and

WHEREAS, No state agency has been otherwise designated by law to apply for, receive and accept such federal funds, and

WHEREAS, The United States of America has indicated willingness to contract with the State of Minnesota through the Department of Iron Range Resources and Rehabilitation,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, hereby designate, pursuant to Minnesota Statutes Section 4.07 (1969), the Department of Iron Range Resources and Rehabilitation as the state agency for such purpose.
