

PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO THE CITY CHARTER OF THE CITY  
OF CROOKSTON ENCLOSED BY THE CHARTER COMMISSION.

September 8th, 1919.

Proposed Amendment No. 1.

Amend Section 59 of said city charter so as to read  
as follows:

"Section 59. There shall be maintained in the  
treasury the following funds: A sinking fund, an interest  
fund, a permanent improvement fund, a poor fund, a library  
fund, a park fund, a general fund, a ward fund for each ward  
in the city, a fire department fund, and a public highway  
fund."

Proposed Amendment No. 11.

Amend said charter so as to include therein a section  
to be known and designated as Section sixty-nine and one-half,  
which section shall read as follows:

"Section 69½. The public highway fund is created to  
aid in the construction, improvement and maintenance of streets  
and highways within the limits of the city and leading to the  
limits of the city. It shall be maintained by a tax levy."

Proposed Amendment No. 111.

Amend said charter so as to include therein an addi-  
tional sub-division to Section 84 of said charter which shall  
read as follows:

"E. Not to exceed two mills on a dollar for the pub-  
lic highway fund."

The foregoing is a draft of three proposed amendments  
to the city charter of the city of Crookston, framed and adopt-  
ed by the commission appointed by the judges of the District  
Court of the Fourteenth Judicial District, State of Minnesota,  
under and pursuant to Section 56, Article 4, of the Constitu-  
tion of the State of Minnesota, and Sections 1342 and 1353 of  
the General Statutes of Minnesota, for the year 1913.

And said draft of said proposed amendments of said  
charter is hereby returned to the Honorable Jas. E. Morrissey,  
mayor of said city, to be submitted to the voters according to  
law.
