

At a meeting of the Board of Directors  
of the Lake Superior & Mississippi Railroad  
Company, held in St. Paul this 24th day  
of February A.D. 1865. - It was unanimously  
"resolved that this Corporation hereby  
"accepts the provisions, grants & conditions of  
"an Act of the Legislature of the State of  
"Minnesota, entitled "An Act to execute the  
"trusts created by the act of Congress entitled  
"an Act making a grant of lands to the  
"State of Minnesota to aid in the construc-  
"tion of the railroad from Saint-Paul  
"to Lake Superior", approved May 5th 1864  
"to grant the said lands to the Lake  
"Superior & Mississippi Railroad Company  
"to aid in the construction of its railroad  
"to amend & continue certain acts in  
"relation to said railroad Company", ap-  
"proved February 23rd, A.D. 1865, and the  
"said Lake Superior & Mississippi Railroad  
"Company hereby agrees to the same,  
"to abide by & perform all acts & things  
"on its part & behalf to be done & performed.

"Resolved further that a duly certified  
"copy of the foregoing resolution be de-  
"posited with the Governor & Secretary of  
"State"
