ORDINANCE NO. 71

AN ORDINANCE TO ANNEX TO THE VILLAGE  
OF ALVARADO CERTAIN UNPLATTED LANDS  
OWNED BY HAROLD J. ERICKSON AND ALOIS  
ERICKSON

The Village Council of the Village of Alvarado, Minnesota, ordains  
as follows:

Section 1. That Harold J. Erickson and Alois Erickson are the sole  
owners of certain real estate located in Marshall County, Minnesota and  
described as follows:

All that part of the Southeast Quarter of the Northeast Quarter  
of Section 6, Township 154 North, Range 49 West of the 5th  
Principal Meridian, which lies East of the Snake River, ex-  
cepting therefrom that part thereof which lies North of a  
line lying parallel to and 740.00 feet South of the North  
line of said Southeast Quarter of the Northeast Quarter  
of Section 6, and also excepting therefrom that part thereof  
which lies South of a line lying parallel to and 1035.00 feet  
South of the North line of said Southeast Quarter of the North-  
east Quarter of Section 6, Township 154 North, Range 49 West  
of the 5th Principal Meridian, and also excepting therefrom  
the East 75 feet thereof.

Section 2. That Harold J. Erickson and Alois Erickson have filed  
a petition requesting that the Village of Alvarado annex the above described  
real estate to the Village of Alvarado; that a copy of said petition was on  
May 10, 1972 filed with the Marshall County Board of Commissioners and  
Martin E. Nelson, Clerk of Vega Township and the Minnesota Municipal Commission;  
that more than sixty days have elapsed since said filing and no objections  
have been received by the Village of Alvarado.

Section 3. That said land is unplatted and does not exceed 200 acres.

Section 4. That the annexation of said real estate is in the best interest  
of the Village of Alvarado and is in the best interest of the above described  
real estate.

Section 5. The Village of Alvarado, Minnesota, hereby ordains and declares  
that the real estate described in Section 1 hereof be and the same hereby is  
annexed to, and included in the Village of Alvarado, Minnesota, as effectively  
as if it had originally been a part thereof.

Section 6. This ordinance shall be final and shall be effective upon its  
publication and after filing a copy of the ordinance with the Minnesota Municipal  
Commission, the Town Clerk, the County Auditor, and the Secretary of State.
