ORDINANCE NO. 220
AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE VILLAGE OF FOREST LAKE
 WHEREAS, the territory described below is not presently within the corporate limits of any incorporated city, village or borough, and
 WHEREAS, the sole owner of the territory described below petitioned the Village Council of the Village of Forest Lake on June 28, 1971 to annex the territory described below to the Village of Forest Lake, and
 WHEREAS, by Resolution adopted by the Village Council of the Village of Forest Lake on June 28, 1971 and served by mail upon the Washington County Board of Commissioners, Forest Lake Town Board, and Minnesota Municipal Commission, by mailing same to them on the 15th day of July, 1971, the said Village Council expressed its intention to annex the territory described below to the Village of Forest Lake, and
 WHEREAS, no objections have been received from any party as to the proposed annexation,
THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF FOREST LAKE, WASHINGTON COUNTY, MINNESOTA, ORDAINS:
SECTION 1. The Corporate limits of the Village of Forest Lake are hereby extended to include the property legally described as follows:
 Lots One (1), Two (2), Three (3), Four (4), Five (5), Six (6), Seven (7), Eight (8), Nine (9) and Ten (10), Block Five (5), and Lots A, B and C, all in Elm Park, according to the survey and plat thereof on file and

of record in the office of the Washington County Register of Deeds.
SECTION 2. The Village Clerk is directed to file certified copies of this Ordinance, together with the Affidavit of Publication thereof with the Secretary of State, the County Auditor of Washington County, Minnesota, and the Minnesota Municipal Commission.
SECTION 3. This Ordinance takes effect upon its passage and its publication and the filing of certified copies as directed in the above Section hereof.
