## ORDINANCE NO 528

## AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF WHITE BEAR LAKE, MINNESOTA TO INCLUDE CERTAIN UNINCORPORATED: UNPLATTED LAND NOT EXCEEDING 200 ACRES IN AREA: ABUTTING UPON THE CITY LIMITS

WHEREAS, a certain petition dated <u>December 28</u>, 1971, requesting annexation of the territory hereinafter described, was duly presented to the Council on the <u>21st</u> day of March , 19 72; and

WHEREAS, the quantity of land embraced within the area described in the petition and bounded as described is 21.752 acres of unplatted land, no part of which is included within the limits of an incorporated city, village or borough; and

WHEREAS, the petition was signed by all owners; and

WHEREAS, no objections to the annexation have been received from the Town Board, the County Board, or the governing body of any municipality whose boundaries abut upon the boundaries of the land to be annexed; and

WHEREAS, land described in the petition abuts upon the City limits at the North and South boundaries thereof;

THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WHITE BEAR LAKE, MINNESOTA, ORDAINS:

1) The City Council hereby determines:

- a) that the annexation will be to the best interests of the City and of the territory affected;
- b) that the territory described herein abuts upon the City limits and is or is about to become urban or suburban in character; and
- c) that none of said territory is now included within the limits of any city, village or borough.
- 2) The corporate limits of the City are hereby extended to include the unplatted land described as follows and the same is hereby annexed to and included within the City as effectually as if it had originally been a part thereof:

The NE ½ of the NE ½ of Section 36, T30N, R22W except the West ½ thereof and except the South 416.22 feet thereof and except that part taken for Highway Purposes as follows: The Easterly 133 feet of the NE ½ of the NE ½ of said Section 36 which lies northerly of a line run parallel with and distant 75 feet southerly of the North line of said Section 36; together with a triangular piece adjoining and southerly of the above described strip and northeasterly of the following described line; beginning at a point distant 133 feet West and 75 feet South of the Northeast corner of said Section 36, thence southeasterly to a point 33 feet West and 175 feet South of the Northeast corner of said Section 36, in addition to the existing highway. Also the East 183 feet of the South 416.22 feet of the NE ½ of the NE ½ of Section 36, T30N, R22W. Subject to County Road E and Century Avenue. Subject to an easement to the City of White Bear Lake over the South 30 feet of the East 183 feet of the NE ½ of the NE ½ of said Section 36.

3) The City Clerk is hereby directed to file certified copies of this ordinance with the Municipal Commission, the Secretary of State and the County Auditor.

4) This ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and publication and the filing of the certified copies as directed in number 3.
