Pursuant to Minnesota Statutes 16.125, 16.13, and 16.135, the following administrative reorganization is hereby made effective July 17, 1972.

The Minnesota Unfair Cigarette Sales Act (MS 325.64 to 325.76) enforcement function of the Commissioner of Taxation is hereby transferred to the Chairman of the Department of Commerce.

The following amounts are hereby transferred from the Department of Taxation to the Department of Commerce:
