WHEREAS: the United States is the only government that does not subsidize its Olympic team, and
WHEREAS: this year it will take some \$10 million to select, equip, house, feed and transport our team of 625 athletes at Munich, Germany, and
WHEREAS: the U. S. Olympic Committee is \$2 million short of that \$10 million goal

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby declare the period of July 4 to July 24, 1972 as

U. S. OLYMPIC FUND DRIVE MONTH

and urge all Minnesota citizens to contribute generously when youngsters of this state ask your support to help send the U. S. Olympic Team to Munich, Germany.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol this twelfth day of July in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and seventy-two and of the State, the one hundred fifteenth.
