

PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS: William P. Murphy served as Associate Justice of the Minnesota Supreme Court from 1955 until his retirement in 1972, and

WHEREAS: For 13 years prior to his appointment to the Minnesota Supreme Court, William P. Murphy gave meritorious service to the Federal Government, first as Assistant United States District Attorney for the State of Minnesota, and later as Regional Director of the Office of Price Stabilization; and

WHEREAS: the People of Minnesota have benefited greatly from the wisdom and dedication William P. Murphy brought to public service over a period of 30 years; and

WHEREAS: William P. Murphy has won the respect, admiration and esteem of all those associated with him;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim Monday, July 17, 1972 as

"WILLIAM P. MURPHY DAY"

in Minnesota.
