Extract from Minutes.

Minutes of the Meetings of the  
"Lake Superior & Mississippi Railroad  
"Corporators.

"St. Paul, Minnesota

"April 13<sup>th</sup> 1861

"At a meeting of the Corporators of the  
"Lake Superior & Mississippi Railroad Company  
"held at the Office of Gynen Dayton Esq. in the  
"City of Saint Paul, Minn. on the 13<sup>th</sup> day of  
"April A.D. 1861. Present in person & by their  
"representative Attorneys in fact, the following  
"named Corporators, to wit:

"Gynen Dayton, John M. Kusick, Henry  
"H. Swift, Dwight Woodbury, Thomas Clark,  
"Sidney Luce, A. G. Hawley, A. G. Whitfield &  
"Orville Clark.

"On motion, Gynen Dayton was chosen  
"Chairman & Charles W. Blair temporary Secretarys  
"motion seconded & carried.

"It was thereupon on motion

"Resolved: That

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"the Corporators named in the Act of the  
"Legislation of this State, entitled an Act to

"amend an Act entitled an Act to Incorporate  
"the Nebraska & Lake Superior Railroad Company  
"approved March 8th, A.D. 1861, hereby accept the  
"said Act, & that proceedings be taken for the  
"permanent organization of said Company,  
"which was unanimously adopted"

I certify that the foregoing is a true &  
correct copy of the Minutes of the meeting  
of the corporators, as therein named, according  
to the records of this Company.

I further certify, that by the said records  
it appears, that at the said meeting on the  
13th day of April, said corporators resolved  
that on the 13th day of May the Books of  
the Company should be opened, for sub-  
scription, at the office of Sylvan Dayton,  
in the City of St. Paul, & that notice thereof  
should be published in both of the daily  
papers published in said City & in the  
Albany Evening Journal, published in Albany  
state of New York. <sup>four or five days</sup> That in pursuance of  
such resolution & notice a meeting of the  
corporators was held on the said 13th day  
of May 1861, & Sylvan Dayton Esq. designated  
as the person to receive the five per cent-  
age of the Capital stock subscribed. That,  
thereafter, on the 8th day of November 1861 a  
meeting of the said corporators was held

That whereas \$198,800 had been subscribed & 5 ps. paid in <sup>in 2500 papers</sup> for 20 days  
at which it was resolved to publish a  
notice of a meeting of the Stockholders to be  
held at the Office of Lyman Dayton, at  
the City of St. Paul, on November 30th 1861,  
for the purpose of electing seven Directors.  
That in pursuance of such resolution & Notice  
a meeting of the Stockholders was held, as  
directed, & resulted in the election of Lyman  
Dayton, Charles St. Clair, Thomas Clark, Wm. L.  
Bishop, Wm. P. Payne, Horace Saxton & C. W. Pelding.
