WHEREAS: many citizens of the State of Minnesota have responded generously to those volunteer opportunities, sharing their talents, skills, and time as volunteers and personally reaching the needs of peoples all over the United States and the world,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, as a special salute to all the citizens of the State of Minnesota who have volunteered to direct their energies, skills, and talents toward the growth of other peoples, do hereby set aside the week of September 3 - 9, 1972, as the second annual
