

SPECIAL ATTORNEY APPOINTMENT

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, WARREN SPANNAUS, Attorney General of the State of Minnesota, by virtue of the authority vested in me by statute, and upon the written request of the State of Minnesota, State College Board (a copy of which is attached), do hereby constitute and appoint

ROBERT C. RUNCHEY

of Marshall, Minnesota, as Special Attorney for the purpose of assisting the Southwest State College in collecting delinquent National Defense Education Act (NDEA) Loans and in such other matters as the College requests, to serve at the pleasure of the Attorney General. This appointment shall be effective August 1, 1972, and is subject to the terms and conditions hereinafter set forth:

1. REPORTS. The Special Attorney shall submit a monthly report setting forth in detail his activities regarding this appointment; as to all matters in litigation, he shall submit a monthly report on forms provided by the Attorney General.

2. COMPENSATION AND EXPENSES. As compensation for satisfactory performance of the legal services rendered to the College, the Special Attorney shall be compensated at the rate of Twenty-Five and No/100 Dollars (\$25.00) per hour; for those legal services rendered in collecting delinquent NDEA loans, he shall be paid one-third (1/3) of the total amount collected. The Special Attorney shall be reimbursed for travel expenses in accordance with the rules and regulations promulgated by the State of Minnesota, Commissioner of Administration governing the travel of state officers and employees. All compensation and expenses shall be paid from funds appropriated to the State College Board.

3. STATUS. The Special Attorney shall not be considered a state employee, shall not be eligible for the state's life insurance or basic health benefits coverage and shall not accrue vacation or sick leave or any benefits other than those expressly provided herein.




