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ORDINANCE NO. 696

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING CERTAIN LAND IN THE COUNTY OF BENTON, MINNESOTA, TO THE CITY OF ST. CLOUD.

WHEREAS, John V. Smith, George N. Smith, Orville E. Peterson, and Palmer J. Peterson, being the owners of a certain tract of land described below situated in Benton County, Minnesota, have filed a petition with the City and presented said petition to the Council requesting that that certain tract of land described below be annexed to the City of St. Cloud and made a part thereof, and

WHEREAS, after due and careful investigation and consideration, it is hereby found, determined and declared:

- 1. That they are all of the property owners of the land described below lying in the Town of Minden, County of Benton, State of Minnesota.
- 2. That said property is unincorporated, abuts on the limits of the City of St. Cloud, and is not included within any other municipality.
- 3. That said property does not exceed 200 acres in area.
- 4. The Town Board of Minden Township, Benton County, Minnesotaj was served notice of the petition for annexation and has not filed objection within 60 days thereafter with the Minnesota Municipal Commission.
- 5. That the interests of the City of St. Cloud and its inhabitants and of the petitioners will be best served by annexation of said tracts of land to the City of St. Cloud.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ST. CLOUD HEREBY ORDAINS THAT the following described tract of land be, and the same hereby is, annexed to the City of St. Cloud, Minnesota, and declared to be a part thereof:

All that part of the Northwest 2 of Section 31, Township 36 North, Range 30 West, Benton County, Minnesota described as follows: Commencing at the Southwest corner of said Northwest 2 of Section 31; thence North on West line thereof 660.0 feet for point of beginning; thence deflect right 91° 16' a distance of 798.00 feet; thence deflect left 91° 16' parallel to said West line of Northwest ½ a distance of 426.74 feet; thence deflect left 47° 47' a distance of 449.45 feet to the Southeasterly right-of-way line of S.T.H. #23; thence Southwesterly, Southeasterly and Southwesterly on said rightof-way line to the West line of said Northwest } of Section 31; thence South on said West line a distance of 176.82 feet to the point of beginning. Together with and subject to an easement to be used with others for the purpose of ingress and egress over the Northwesterly 40 feet thereof. Said tract containing 9.17 acres, more or less.
