ORDINANCE NO. 1972-D

AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE VILLAGE OF ST. JOSEPH TO INCLUDE CERTAIN UNINCORPORATED, UNPLATTED LAND BORDERED ON THREE SIDES BY LAND WITHIN THE VILLAGE LIMITS AND ABUTTING THEREON.

WHEREAS, certain territory described below is not presently included within the corporate limits of any incorporated city, village, or borough; and

WHEREAS, this territory is Sixty (60%) percent or more bordered by land within the Village of St. Joseph and is deemed to be urban in character; and

WHEREAS, notice of intent to annex said land was served upon the officers of the Township of St. Joseph, the County of Stearns, and the Municipal Commission of the State of Minnesota on April 28, 1972, and

WHEREAS, no objections have been filed with the Minnesota Municipal Commission with regard to the proposed annexation.

NOW THEREFORE, the Village Council of the Village of St. Joseph, Minnesota, ordains:

Section 1. Territory Annexed. The corporate limits of the Village of St. Joseph, Minnesota are hereby extended to include the unplatted territory described as follows, which territory is now and has heretofore been Sixty (60%) percent or more bordered by land within the Village of St. Joseph and is urban in character:

All that part of the Northwest Quarter of the Southeast Quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$) and of the Northeast Quarter of the Southwest Quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Ten (10), Township One Hundred Twenty Four (124), Range Twenty Nine (29), Stearns County, Minnesota, lying Southerly of the centerline of former Trunk Highway No. 52, which is not now a part of the Village of St. Joseph.

Section 2. Filing. The Village Clerk is hereby directed to file certified copies of this notice with the Secretary of State, the County Auditor, and the Register of Deeds of the County in which the property is located, and the Minnesota Municipal Commission.

Section 3. Effective Date of Annexation. This Ordinance takes effect upon the passage and publication and the filing of certified copies as directed in Section 2.
