ORDINANCE NO. 170

AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE VILLAGE OF LE CENTER TO INCLUDE CERTAIN UNINCORPORATED PLATTED LANDS NOT EXCEEDING 200 ACRES IN AREA ABUTTING UPON THE VILLAGE LIMITS

WHEREAS, petition requesting the annexation of the territory hereinafter described was duly presented to the Village Council; and

WHEREAS, the quantity of land embraced within the area described in the petition and bounded as described is less than 200 acres of platted land, no part of which is included within the limits of any incorporated city, village, or borough; and

WHEREAS, the petition signed by all the owners of said land; and

WHEREAS, no objections to the annexation have been received from the town boards, the county boards, or the governing body of any municipality whose boundary abuts upon the boundaries of the lands to be annexed; and

WHEREAS, the land described in the petition abuts upon the village limits at the East boundaries thereof;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the Village of Le Center, Minnesota, ordains:

SECTION 1 - The Village Council hereby determines (1) that the annexation will be to the best interests of the Date. This ordinance takes effect upon its passage and publication and the filing of the certified copies as directed in Section 3.

WHEREAS, petition re-
questing the annexation of
the territory hereinafter des-
cribed was duly presented to
the Village Council; and

WHEREAS, the quantity of
land embraced within the
area described in the petition
and bounded as described is
less than 200 acres of platted
land, no part of which is in-
cluded within the limits of
any incorporated city, village,
or borough; and

WHEREAS, the petition
signed by all the owners of
said land; and

WHEREAS, no objections
to the annexation have been
received from the town
boards, the county boards, or
the governing body of any
municipality whose boundary
abuts upon the boundaries of
the lands to be annexed; and

WHEREAS, the land des-
cribed in the petition abuts
upon the village limits at the
East boundaries thereof;

NOW, THEREFORE, the
Council of the Village of Le
Center, Minnesota, ordains:

SECTION 1 — The Village
Council hereby determines
(1) that the annexation will
be to the best interests of the
village and of the territories
affected; (2) that the terri-
tories described herein abuts
upon the village limits and is
urban or suburban in charac-
ter; and (3) that none of said
territories are now included
within the limits of any city,
village or borough.

SECTION 2 — Territory an-
nexed. The corporate limits
of the village are hereby ex-
tended to include the platted
land described as follows and
the same is hereby annexed
to and included within the vil-
lage as effectually as if it had
originally been a part there-
of.

Parcel I, owned by Patrick
J. O'Meara and Gloria J.
O'Meara, husband and wife,
described as follows, to-wit:

East Half (E½) of Lots
4 and 5, Block 1, G. W.
Dickinson's 1st Addition
and the South 300 feet of
Lot 3, Block 1, G. W. Dic-
kinson's 2nd Addition to
the Town of Lexington.

Parcel II, owned by Clem-
ent T. Groh, and Alice V.
Groh, husband and wife, de-
scribed as follows, to-wit:

Lot 1 and East Half
(E½) of Lots 2 and 3,
Block 1, G. W. Dickinson's
1st Addition to the Town
of Lexington.

SECTION 3 — Filing. The
village clerk is hereby direct-
ed to file certified copies of
this ordinance with the Min-
nesota Municipal Commission,
the Secretary of State and the
County Auditor.

SECTION 4 — Effective
Date. This ordinance takes

publication and the filing of
the certified copies as directed
in Section 3.
