At a duly held meeting of the Council for the Village of Floodwood at Floodwood, Minnesota, on August 22, 1972, the following ordinance was unanimously adopted:

ORDAINED, That the Village of Floodwood in the County of St. Louis, State of Minnesota, a municipal corporation, does hereby annex and incorporate within its boundaries the following described land located in St. Louis County, Minnesota, to-wit:

That part of the Northwest one-quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of the Northeast one-quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$ ) described as follows: Commencing at the Northeast (NE) corner of the Northwest one-quarter of the Northeast one-quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of NE $\frac{1}{4}$ ), thence South one hundred fifty-four (154) feet to a point, thence West two hundred twelve (212) feet to a point, thence North one hundred fifty-four (154) feet, thence East two hundred twelve (212) feet to the point of beginning, all in Section Seven (7), Township Fifty-one (51), Range Twenty (20).

Said property now being unincorporated and abutting the Village of Floodwood and not included in any other municipality and said property being less than 200 acres.




