

PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS: there are a wide variety of effective non-prescription drugs to treat minor, self-diagnosed illnesses; and

WHEREAS: there are non-prescription drug products of questionable safety and effectiveness advertised with exaggerated claims; and

WHEREAS: the pharmacists of our State are experts who can advise our citizens on the safe and effective use of non-prescription drugs and remedies;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota do hereby proclaim October 1 - 7, 1972 as

"NATIONAL PHARMACY WEEK"

in Minnesota. I further call upon the appropriate agencies of the State government, local governments and private organizations to join in our pharmacists' efforts to alert our citizens to the need for caution and care in the use of non-prescription drugs.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol this twenty-eighth day of September in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and seventy-two and of the State, the one hundred Fifteenth.
