AN ORDINATED ANNEXING A PORTION OF THE NEW OF THE LEW OF SECTION 25, TOTAL 21 ANY SECTION 25, TOTAL 21 ANY SECTION 25, TOTAL 21

The Village Council of Hinckley ordains:

Section I. WHEREAS, Gerald J. Von Rueden and Dorothy Von Rueden, hip taken are the owners of the following described premises located in the County of Pice.
State of Minnesota, described as follows, to-wit:

That part of the Northeast Quarter of the Northeast Quarter, Section 15. Township 41. North, Range 21, West, described as follows: Commencing at the Northwest corner of said Northeast Quarter; theses East along the North Ring of said Section 25, 437 feet to the point of beginning; thence West along the North line of said Section 25, a distance of One Mundred Seventy-sin first; thence South parallel to the West line of said Northeast Quarter 210 first; thence East parallel to the North line of said Northeast Quarter a distance of 176 feet to the West to the right-of-way line of U.S. Interstate Mightany No. 35; thence North along said highway right-of-way a distance of 210 feet, more or less to the point of beginning; subject to Trunk Nighway 48 over the North 50 feet thereof.

SECTION II. WHEREAS, said above described premises are unplatted and do not exceed two hundred acres and are solely owned by said Gerald J. BE IT MEREBY CRDAINED, That the Village Council of the Village of Hinckley pursuant to Minnesota Statutes Annotated 414.033 (Subd. 5) does hereby annex said above described lands and premises to the Village of Minckley and the Clerk of the Village Council of the Village of Minckley is hereby directed to forthwith send copies of this Ordinance to the Minnesota Municipal Commission of the State of Minhesota, the Town Clerk of the Township of Minckley, the Pine County Auditor, and the Secretary of State of the State of Minnesota.
