

ORDINANCE NO. 221

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER II,
SECTION VI OF THE CITY CHARTER, OF
THE CITY OF SPRINGFIELD, MINNESOTA
RELATING TO APPOINTIVE OFFICERS OF
SAID CITY.

The City Council of the City of Springfield does ordain:

I.

The amended charter of the City of Springfield, duly adopted on the 15th day of May, 1950, and becoming effective August 24, 1950, and amendments thereto, Chapter II, Section VI, reads as follows:

"Appointive Officers--At the first meeting after the annual election, the Council shall appoint the following officers, who shall hold office for a term of one year, and until his successor is appointed and has qualified, or is removed: City Clerk, City Attorney, City Assessor, who may be assigned such additional duties as the Council shall direct.

"Each of said officers shall be a resident and qualified voter of the city."

II.

The above section of the charter is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Appointive Officers:--At the first meeting after the annual election, the City Council shall appoint the following officers, who shall hold office for a term of one year, and until his successor is appointed and has qualified, or is removed: City Clerk, City Attorney, City Assessor, who may be assigned such additional duties as the Council shall direct.

"Each of said officers shall be a resident and qualified voter of the city of Springfield or have his main office, or business or place of employment within the city limits."

This ordinance becomes effective ninety (90) days after passage and publication.






