



SPECIAL COUNCIL MEETING NOVEMBER 9, 1972

The Council of the City of Faribault met in special session in the City Recorder's Office at City Hall on Thursday, November 9, 1972, at 11 a.m. The meeting was called to order by Mayor Miller. On roll call those present were: Councilmen Muellermeister, Pettipiece, and Mayor Miller. Councilman Kalien and Councilman Purdie were absent. The meeting was called to canvass the votes of the General Election held November 7, 1972.

Relative to Canvas of Returns of the General Election held November 7, 1972.

Pettipiece, Commissioner of Water Works and Sewers; and Certificates for Mayor and Councilmen to expire December 31, 1976.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: That the vote on Liquor Option City of Faribault be declared correct the vote for special license being 2,610; The vote against special license being 3,987.
