

EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 48

Providing for assistance to  
officials of Itasca County,  
Grand Rapids, Minnesota

I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, by the virtue of the authority vested in me by the Constitution and applicable statutes, hereby, issue this Executive Order:

WHEREAS, officials of Itasca County, Grand Rapids, request search assistance in order to locate a missing person;

NOW THEREFORE, I order that:


1. The Adjutant General of Minnesota will order to active duty in the service of the state, such elements of the military forces of the state as are required to aid civilian agencies in searching for a lost person in Itasca County, Minnesota: and that
2. Cost of subsistence, transportation, pay and allowances of said individuals will be defrayed from the General Revenue of the State, as provided for by Minnesota Statutes, Section 192.49; Subdivision 1, Section 192.51; and Section 192.52.

This Order shall be effective on 3 November 1972.


