ORDINANCE NO. 165

ORDINALCE DEGLARIES CERTALS LAUD III EXPIRE TOUSSELP ANDEXED TO THE VILLAGE OF PARTHEBEOU

The Village Council of the Village of Farmington do ordain as follows:

Section 1.

That all of the owners of all of the land hereinafter described have patitioned the Villago Council of the Village of Formington to have said land included within the Village of Formington.

Section 2.

That coid land does not exceed 200 acros in area, is territory abutting on the Village of Farmington, is not included in any other village or in any city or borough, and is so conditioned as properly to be subjected to the government of the Village of Farmington.

Section 3.

That it is hereby determined that the appearation of said land to the village of Farmington will be, and is, to the best interests of the Village of Farmington and of the territory affected.

Section 4.

That there is hereby annamed to the Village of Farmington all the land lying and being in the County of Dakota and State of Minnesota, described as follows, to-wit;

Commencing at a point on the South line of Section 30, Township 114, Range 19, Dakota County, Minnesota, due North of the Northwest corner of Lat 4, Block 1, Bung's Addition seconding to the recorded plat thereof; thence North 267 feet; thence East on a line parallel to the South line of said Section 30 to the West line of Minnesota highway No. 218 right-of-way; thence Southerly along the highway right-of-way to the South line of said Section 30; thence West along the South line of said Section 30 to the point of beginning.

Section 5.

That caid ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication and the filing of certified copies with the Minnesota Municipal Commission, the County Auditor of Dakota County and the Secretary of tate, as required by law.

This Ordinance No. 165 was passed and approved the 22nd day of October, 1968 at a special meeting of the Village Council.
