



AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF
THE VILLAGE OF NORWOOD TO INCLUDE CERTAIN UNIN-
CORPORATED TERRITORY ADJUTED BY LAND WITHIN THE
VILLAGE LIMITS

WHEREAS, a certain petition dated July 14,
1972, requesting certain territory described below be annexed to the Village
of Norwood, and,

WHEREAS, this certain territory described
below abuts the present corporate limits of the Village of Norwood, does
not exceed 200 acres in area and is not presently included within the
corporate limits of any incorporated City, Village or Borough, and

WHEREAS, the Municipal Commission of the
State of Minnesota has approved said petition,

The Village Council of the Village of
Norwood ordains:

Section 1. Territory annexed. The corporate
limits of the Village of Norwood, Minnesota, are hereby extended to include
the territory described as follows:

TRACT 1 Commencing at a point which is 33 feet South and 1127.06
feet East of the Southwest corner of the Northwest Quarter of the
Southwest Quarter of Section 14, Township 115, Range 26, thence
running South variation 10° East 367.4 feet; thence running East
55 feet thence running North 367.4 feet; thence running West
55 feet to the place of beginning, situate in Lot 1, Section 14,
Township 115, Range 26.

Tract 2 Commencing at a point which is 33 feet South and 1304.2
feet East of the Southwest corner of the Northwest Quarter of
the Southwest Quarter of Section 14, Township 115, Range 26;
thence running South variation 10° East 367.4 feet, thence running
West 62.14 feet; thence running North 367.4 feet; thence running
East 62.14 feet to the place of beginning situated in Lot 1,
Section 14, Township 115, Range 26.

Tract 3 Commencing at a point which is 33 feet South and 1127.06
feet East of the Southwest corner of the Northwest Quarter of
Southwest Quarter of Section 14, Township 115, Range 26; thence
running South, variation 10° East, 367.4 feet; thence East 60
feet; thence North 367.4 feet; thence running West 60 feet to the
place of beginning, situated in Lot One (1) of Section 14, Township
115, Range 26, and containing 0.51 acres.

Tract 4 Commencing at a point which is 33 feet South and 1067.06
feet East of the Southwest corner of the Northwest Quarter of the
Southwest Quarter of Section 14, Township 115, Range 26, thence
running South variation 10° East, 367.4 feet; thence running East
60 feet; thence running North 367.4 feet; thence West running
60 feet to the place of beginning, situated in Lot 1, Section 14,
Township 115, Range 26, containing 0.51 acres.

Tract 5 Also all that certain land 33 feet in width presently
used as a public street lying and abutting between the presently
southerly corporate limits of the Village of Norwood and the
northerly line of the afore described tracts

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Section 2. Filing. The Village Clerk is directed to file certified copies of this ordinance with the Secretary of State, the County Auditor of the county in which the property is located, and the Minnesota Municipal Commission.

Section 3. Effective Date of Annexation.

This ordinance takes effect upon passage and publication and the filing of certified copies as directed in Section 2.

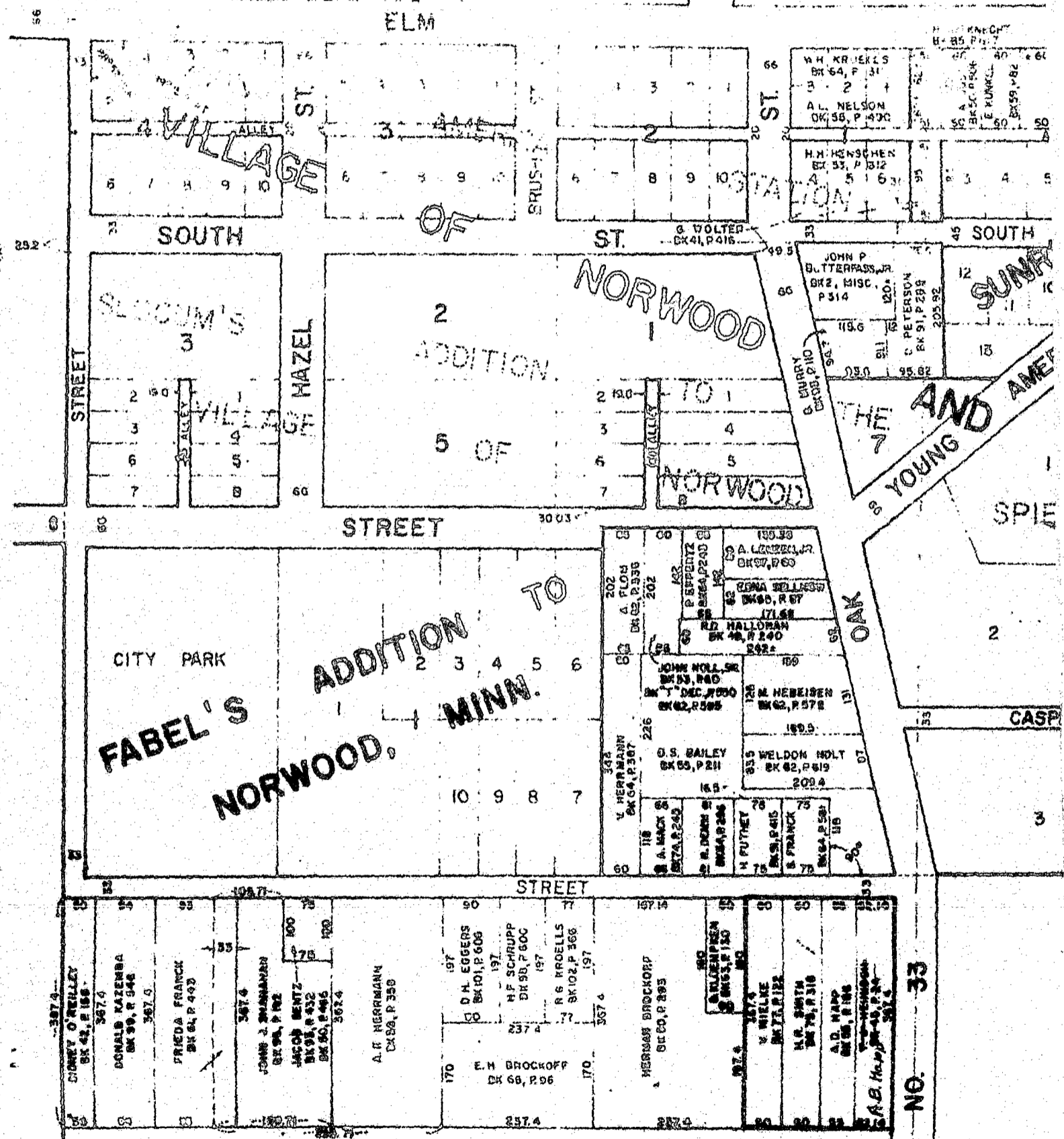
