

At a meeting of the Board of Directors of the Minneapolis Union Railway Company held at the office of said Company at the City of St Paul on August 8th 1883, the following resolution was offered and adopted by said Company

Resolved that this Company does hereby accept and become subject to the provisions of Chapter 111 of the special laws of the year 1873 entitled "An act providing for the collection of taxes from the St Paul Stillwater and Taylors Falls Railroad Company and other railroad companies" and does hereby promise and agree with the State of Minnesota to pay the percentages on its gross earnings as required by said law in full of all taxation and assessment whatever.
